



Information must remain accurate at all times






#### Point of Contact Change Request Process


#### As Stated in M-1003, section 3.9.5.1:

A *facility* is responsible for assuring both the *facility*/corporate point of contacts remain current within the online system at <a href="http://aar.iirx.net">http://aar.iirx.net</a>. All assigned point of contact individuals must have an active account in the online system. Change requests must be completed through the online system at <a href="http://aar.iirx.net">http://aar.iirx.net</a>.





### Point of Contact Change Request Process







