1. Coordination fees are per frequency/location (Simplex) or per repeater pair (FB2).
2. FB2 Repeater pairs priced the same as simplex frequencies.
3. Trunked FB6/FB8 pairs or FXOs priced the same as simplex frequencies.
4. Processing fee covers license updates that require coordination but no searches.
5. Filing fee covers FCC Returns Processing, Construction Notices, and license updates that do not require coordination.
6. FCC fees are waived for Government Entities.
7. \$100 regulatory fee waived for non-profit organizations with proof of 501(c)3 status.
8. All fees subject to change without notice.
9. FCC fees are paid by AAR after application submission to the FCC and are included in coordination invoice.
10. Petitions for Reconsideration are charged a processing fee plus a \$35 fee per attachment.
11. Waiver Request Preparation are charge a processing fee plus a \$35 fee per attachment.
12. Government Entities are exempt from all FCC fees. Coordination fees apply.
13. Non-Profit organizations are exempt from FCC regulatory fees with 501(c)3 attachment. Application fees apply.
